

8 WEEK PROGRAM FOR ADULTS WITH DISABILITIES (AND THEIR CARER)

THE SESSIONS ARE RUN FOR 2 HOURS EACH WEEK ACROSS THE 8 WEEK PROGRAM.

FAQ

Pricing

PRICE IS APPROX. \$800 PER TERM (8 WEEKS)

- Light morning tea (please advise if you have special dietary needs)
- Drink (Tea, coffee or cold can drink)
- 2 Farmer Co-ordinators to run each day
- Learning sheets to take home.
